- * Exhibit respect for self, family, and community.
- * Demonstrate ambition, initiative, and self-drive as evidenced by outstanding achievement in school, the community, or the workplace.
- * Submit two letters of recommendation by an unrelated adult professional who can attest to the student's achievement.
- * Be involved in public service, and extra-curricular activities.

- * Submit official transcripts.
- * Type application essay in size of 12 point and double spaced.
- * Complete application (including family information)
- * Be available for an oral interview
- * Be available to attend the Links' scholarship awards event.
- * Submit all required information by the **deadline, Tuesday, March 12, 2019**
